

Todd Selby's Bright, Bubbly Desk Accessories Are Perfect for Spring

In 2008, Todd Selby's blog was a showcase for creative types in their personal spaces. In the decade since, it's evolved into an international multimedia project of sorts—with [museum shows](#), [books](#), and the occasional [Miranda Kerr collaboration](#). Come early May, you can inject some of the quirky illustrator's style into your life, or at least enliven your desk, with his [Box of Wonders](#) note cards and [Book of Wonders](#) journal.

The cards feature his distinctive whimsical watercolors—one is a tribute to all things carbohydrate (think donuts, ramen, pizza), another assembles a deep sea pastiche (mermaids, jellyfish, and sunken ships)—with designs likely to please both your inner [Maira Kalman](#) and your inner four-year-old. The notebook and the note cards also include stickers several steps above the ones that decorated your Trapper Keeper—not to knock the iconic binder, as the Book of Wonders' magnetic flap and varied paper directly channels the '90s accessory stuffed in many a Jansport. If this all seems a bit eclectic, that's precisely the point: "The world is filled with so many wonderful colorful crazy things," says Selby. "I thought it would be fun to pull from all that randomness."
